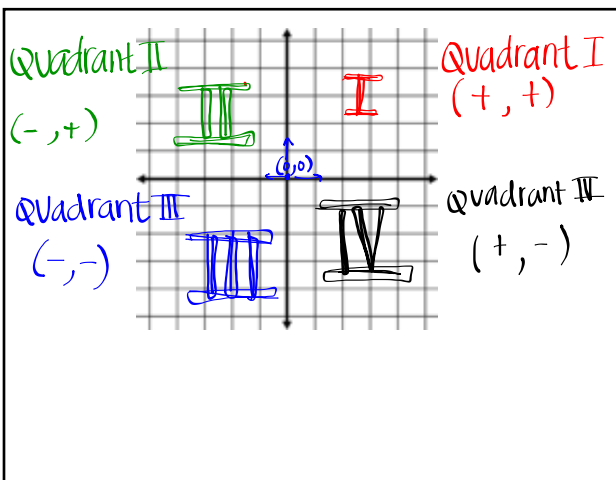
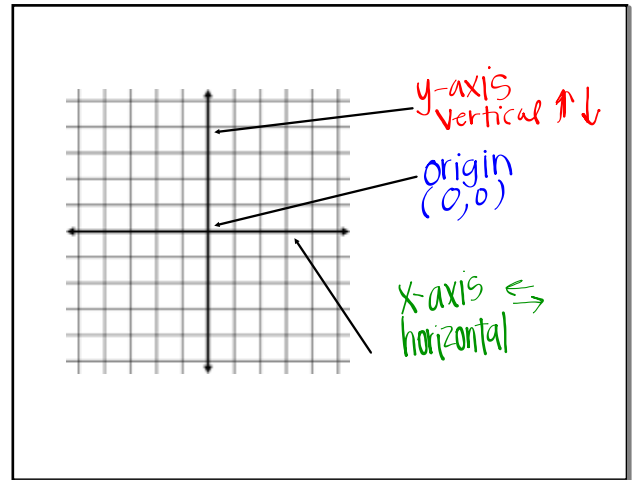


1. A coordinate plane is formed by two axes that intersect at a 90° angle.
2. Each point in the plane corresponds to an ordered pair of real numbers.
3. The first number in an ordered pair is the x-value.
4. The second number is the y-value.



The x-coordinate determines the movement Right and left
 (+) (-)

The y-coordinate determines the movement up and down
 (+) (-)
